

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
1N after 1/1 very solid: (9)10-14
2cue=3fit
2N=4fit
3cue=mixed raise when jump to 3cue is available
2/1 very constructive, unless special reason
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
1NT = 15-17
4 <sup>th</sup> seat: (10)11-14(15)
In both cases, system on.
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Aggressive when nV, sometimes 5 at fav
Weak.
1C-2D=majors, 2C=nat
Reopen: cue=majors or unknown michaels
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
2Cue=highest 2 suits, 2NT=outer 2 suits, 3 cue=lower suits
Over 1C: 2D=2Cue 2C=nat
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
Multi-Landy, double is penalty (15+ vs strong, vs weak, 14/12(4th)+)
VS weak 1NT-X-2x-? and 1NT-p-2X-X-p-? =T-Lebensohl
<b>VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
VS weak 2-style bids: -X-p-Lebensohl
Leaping Michaels up to (3C)-4C/D
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
Vs. strong 1/2♣: double = majors, NT = minors
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
Xfers up to 2X

1NT = (14) 15-17 In all other positions
1C-1D= any 0-7 OR walsh D OR non-inv 44MM
1C also contains 3352 (17)18-19

No transfers over 10-13 1NT!
2♣ = inv or Stayman
